Varietal Composition: 100% Pinot Noir

Winemaker Tasting Notes: The extended skin contact produces a full bodied, richly textured rosé that is extraordinarily food-friendly. Beautiful bouquet of raspberry, lychee, bubble gum and cotton candy. The palette is dry with notes of raspberry, peach, melon and a hint of rosemary. Fermented in stainless steel tanks.

Enjoy: Child's Play wines are made to be enjoyed upon release -- straight forward, fruit focused and delicious, yet can be aged for a few years if you prefer (1-2 years from vintage date for our Rosé). Serve chilled at 50-55F or after about 30 minutes in the fridge.

Favorite Pairings: Grilled fish, Niçoise salad, chicken salad sandwich, couscous, grilled cauliflower, Camembert.
