



2015 Child's Play Pinot Noir

Varietal Composition: 100% Pinot Noir

Winemaker Tasting Notes: The wine displays aromas of fresh violet, red raspberry, cherry, black tea, slight cedar, and spiced plum. The palate full and round, with wild berry, pie cherry, slight licorice, tarragon, and soft tannins.

56% Yamhill-Carlton
35% Eola-Amity Hills
9 % Willamette Valley

Aging & Cooperage: 10 months in French oak barrels; primarily neutral
