



2016 Child's Play Pinot Chardonnay

Varietal Composition: 70% Chardonnay and 30% "white" Pinot Noir from the 2016 vintage

Winemaker Tasting Notes: In the nose, this wine displays aromas of quince, Bosc pear, white peach, wet stone, citrus flower, and honeydew melon. The palate is fresh and juicy, showing flavors of Galia melon, margarita mix, fresh strawberry, with lingering hints of wet stone.

AVA: 100% Willamette Valley with sub-appellation composition: 100% Yamhill-Carlton

Aging & Cooperage: 7 months in stainless steel
