



2016 Child's Play Rosé of Pinot Noir

Varietal Composition: 100% Pinot Noir

Winemaker Tasting Notes: In the nose, this wine shows rose petal, wild strawberry, slight passion fruit, cherry pie filling, and key lime. The palate is round and fleshy, highlighted by fresh strawberry, red plum, citrus, passion fruit and blood orange.

AVA: 100% Willamette Valley with sub-appellation composition:
70% Yamhill-Carlton
30% Chehalem Mountains

Aging & Coopersage: six months in stainless steel
