2013 C Note Pinot Noir

Varietal Composition: 100% whole cluster Pinot Noir

Winemaker Tasting Notes: The nose is dominated by complex aromas of blackberry, rosemary, Darjeeling tea, slight smoke and cardamom. The palate is rich and persistent; showing layers of blackberry, raspberry cordial, allspice, green tea, black cherry, and cocoa powder on a sturdy frame of supple tannins.

AVA: 100% Willamette Valley with sub-appellation composition: 100% Yamhill-Carlton

Aging & Cooperage: 17 months in French oak barrels; 100% new with 3-year air-dried staves

Bottled: April 2015

Cases Produced: 73

Enjoy: Tendril wines are made “low and slow,” just like great food: we give them time to reach their full potential at the winery, aging 16 months minimum in barrel and 6-18 months more in bottle before release. If you prefer aging, 3-15 years from vintage date is ideal for C-Note. Serve at 58-62F.

Favorite Pairings: grilled lamb with rosemary, compound butter filet, vegetable terrine
