Varietal Composition: 100% Zinfandel

Winemaker Tasting Notes: Aromas of blueberries, dark plum, tobacco, and blackberry fruit leather. On the palate the wine is supple and soft, with lots of plum, fig, blackberry, and anise.

AVA: 100 % Columbia Valley with sub-appellation composition:
Red Mountain

Aging & Cooperage: Twelve months in French oak.
