Varietal Composition: 100% Pinot Noir

Winemaker Tasting Notes: Aromas leap from the glass with beautiful fresh strawberry, red raspberry, wild cherry, cotton candy and galia melon. The palate is soft and round with lovely ripe strawberry, cantaloupe, watermelon, and rose petal with a soft finish.

AVA: 100% Willamette Valley with sub-appellation composition:
75% Yamhill-Carlton
25% Chehalem Mountains

Aging & Cooperage: 3 months in stainless steel tanks, no malolactic fermentation was encouraged

Bottled: December, 2019

Enjoy: Child's Play wines are made to be approachable and fruit focused. While delicious upon release, they also have the ability for modest aging. Serve lightly chilled at 50-55°F or after about 30 minutes in the fridge.
