Varietal Composition: 100% Pinot Noir

Winemaker Tasting Notes: This wine is like biting into ripe fruit – juicy huckleberry, boysenberry and cranberry. Soft tannins coat the palate, the nose is herbaceous and the finish is redolent of bing cherries.

AVA: 100% Willamette Valley with sub-appellation composition:
74% Yamhill-Carlton
18% Willamette Valley
8% Dundee Hills

Aging & Cooperage: 11 months in once or twice filled French oak barrels.

Bottled: December 2018

Enjoy: Child's Play wines are made to be enjoyed upon release -- straight forward, fruit focused and delicious, yet can be aged for a few years if you prefer (2-5 years from vintage date for our Pinot Noir). Serve at 58-62F
