Varietal Composition: 100% Pinot Noir

Winemaker Tasting Notes: The nose shows notes of juicy mid-summer blackberry, cherry, plum and cedar. The palate is redolent of blueberry, plum and blackberry. The wine is well structured with smooth tannins and a surprisingly long finish.

AVA: 100% Willamette Valley with sub-appellation composition:
73% Yamhill-Carlton
27% Willamette Valley

Aging & Cooperage: 12 months in once or twice filled French oak barrels.

Enjoy: Child's Play wines are made to be enjoyed upon release -- straight forward, fruit focused and delicious, yet can be aged for a few years if you prefer (2-5 years from vintage date for our Pinot Noir). Serve at 58-62F
