Varietal Composition: 100% Pinot Noir

Winemaker Tasting Notes: Aromas of black raspberry, blueberry, and ripe black cherry. The palate is full of juicy berries and eucalyptus and features silky tannins and a surprisingly long finish.

AVA: 100% Willamette Valley with sub-appellation composition:
60% Eola-Amity
40% Yamhill-Carlton

Aging & Cooperage: 6 months in once or twice filled French oak barrels.

Bottled: April 2022

Cases Produced: 1000

Enjoy: Child's Play wines are made to be enjoyed upon release -- straight forward, fruit focused and delicious, yet can be aged for a few years if you prefer (2-5 years from vintage date for our Pinot Noir). Serve at 58-62F
