



2018 **TIGHTROPE** PINOT NOIR

Varietal Composition: 100% Pinot Noir (partial whole cluster)

Winemaker Tasting Notes: Aromas of black cherry, anise and sweet baking spices lead to flavors of black raspberry and subtle hints of anise and caramel. Silky tannins provide a luscious, rich mouthfeel with a persistent finish.

AVA: 100% Willamette Valley with subappellation composition: 100% Yamhill-Carlton

Aging & Cooperage: 17 months in 50% new

French oak barrels

Bottled: April 2020

Cases Produced: 150

Enjoy: Tendril wines are made "low and slow," just like great food: we give them time to reach their full potential at the winery, aging 16 months minimum in barrel and 6-18 months more in bottle before release. If you prefer aging, 3-15 years from vintage date is ideal for TightRope. Serve at 58-62F.
